Whaly 370 with Parsun 20 hp outboard; compact, stable boat for inland waters and leisure

The Whaly 370 is a popular choice for anyone looking for a practical, robust and versatile plastic boat for recreational boating on inland waters. With a length of 3.70 metres and a beam of 1.73 metres, this Whaly offers a noticeably spacious feel on board, while the shallow draft of around 10 cm makes it highly suitable for shallow lakes, canals, ditches and calm river stretches. This version is fitted with a V-hull, which contributes to good tracking and a pleasant, stable experience when heading out with several people. The boat has been used on inland waters, lakes and ponds and is ideal for a day on the water, sporty cruising or, for example, a fishing trip.

Hull, material and handling
What sets the Whaly 370 apart is its double-walled plastic construction. This type of material is chosen for intensive use: it is impact-resistant, practical in everyday use and requires little attention compared to more traditional materials. For buyers looking for a boat that can easily be used for spontaneous trips, that is a major advantage. The V-hull also helps the boat cut neatly through the water and provides extra control in turns and in changing conditions on open water. Even with passengers on board, the Whaly 370 remains stable, increasing comfort during relaxed cruising or when lying still to swim or fish.

The layout is focused on functionality. There is practical storage space in the bow for items such as lines, an anchor, life jackets or a bag with provisions. In addition, the boat is self-draining, allowing rainwater to run off via the drainage system. This makes the Whaly 370 attractive for moorings where the boat is often kept outside and you don't want to bail it out every time before heading out.

Engine: Parsun F20 20 hp (2026); lively and controllable

Mounted on the transom is a Parsun F20 20 hp outboard, a four-stroke petrol engine with two cylinders and manual start. The delivery year is 2026 and, according to the information provided, the engine has not yet been used; an appealing point for many buyers: you start with a fresh base and can run in and use the engine from day one according to your own preferences. The 20 hp output suits the size of the Whaly 370 perfectly and provides brisk acceleration and lively handling, without the boat losing its accessible character. For those who like to cruise a bit more sportily or regularly go out with several people on board, this engine offers a comfortable margin.

The set is supplied with a new 20-litre petrol tank, which is practical for day trips on lakes and ponds or longer routes through canals and waterways. The combination of a light, manoeuvrable hull and a modern four-stroke outboard makes this Whaly 370 suitable for a wide range of boating plans: from relaxed cruising to active trips and mooring at small beaches or jetties.

Use cases and target audience
This Whaly 370 is of interest to buyers looking for a compact boat with broad usability. Think of families wanting an accessible leisure boat for an afternoon on the water, as well as watersports enthusiasts looking for a strong tender-like solution for transport, fishing or exploring narrow waterways. Thanks to the limited draft and manageable size, manoeuvring is easy, even in tight canals or at busy moorings. At the same time, the 1.73-metre beam provides a stable platform, making time on board comfortable.

Condition, documentation and maintenance
According to the information provided, the boat is in good condition and no known defects have been reported. Documentation includes an engine booklet.

All in all, this Whaly 370 with Parsun 20 hp is an attractive combination for anyone looking for a low-maintenance plastic boat with a true-tracking V-hull, a spacious feel for its length and a modern four-stroke outboard.
