Powered by a Mercury Verado 350HP outboard engine with just 95 hours as at 20th March 2026, this boat delivers impressive performance with smooth, responsive handling. The engine was last serviced on 16th May 2025, providing reassurance to her next owner that she is ready for the season ahead.

The Suncruiser 730 is well known for its clever use of space, featuring a generous cockpit with ample seating, a convertible sunpad, and an ergonomic helm position. Below deck, the cabin offers comfortable accommodation, ideal for overnight stays, with practical storage and a well-designed layout.

Accommodation :

The accommodation on the **Atlantic Marine Sun Cruiser 730 (2021)** is cleverly designed to maximise comfort within a compact 7.3m sports cruiser, making it ideal for weekend use and occasional overnighiting.

Below decks, the boat features a **single open-plan cabin** finished in light, modern beige upholstery, creating a bright and welcoming feel. The main seating area converts into a **comfortable double berth**, suitable for two adults.

Storage is well thought out, with **under-seat lockers and side shelving**, along with a small **galley-style unit** incorporating a fridge and space for basic catering equipment with pressurised cold water. To starboard, there is a **separate enclosed heads compartment**, fitted with a sink and shower, with provision for a marine toilet with a 100 litre holding tank – offering useful independence for short cruising trips.

Headroom is generous at the companionway entrance, giving easier access, although the cabin is primarily designed for sitting rather than full standing throughout.

Overall, the accommodation is best described as **practical and comfortable for weekend cruising**, providing all the essentials in a compact, stylish layout, complemented by the boat's spacious cockpit and large sunbathing areas on deck.

History && Construction

Built in 2021 this Atlantic Marine SunCruiser 730a has a blue GRP hull and teak decks. It has teak seats in the cockpit aft cockpit area. Wheel steering. Aluminium toe rails. Stainless steel stanchions, pulpit. Glass screen with full cockpit cover. Walk through transom gate to the bathing platform. Teak battens to the bathing platform—self-draining cockpit. The owner has unfortunately suffered a back injury which means that he cannot use the vessel.

Mechanical Systems:

This Atlantic SunCruiser 730 has a single Mercury Verado, 350HP petrol outboard engine with a 4-blade prop. The engine has direct cooling. The engine has completed a total of 95 hours as of 20th March 2026. The engine was last serviced in May 2025. There is a 250-litre steel fuel tank. This sports cruiser has a cruising speed of 28 knots, and a maximum speed of 48 knots. To make handling easy, this boat is fitted with Trim tabs and a through-tunnel bow thruster.

Electrical Systems

2 x 12-volt batteries (1 x engine + 1 x domestic), all new in 2021, charging from alternator and via 240v shore power system with ring main, and battery charger.
