Lamberti Yama 22P7 (2018) console boat with Mercury 200 hp and road trailer ; sporty boating on inland waters

The 2018 Lamberti Yama 22P7 is a modern console boat aimed at enthusiasts of fast yet comfortable boating on inland waters. With an overall length of approx. 6.50 metres and a beam of 2.50 metres, this model offers a pleasant balance between onboard space and ease of handling when docking, trailering and manoeuvring. The GRP hull with V-bottom is designed to track well and cut through waves neatly, which is especially noticeable when the water gets a bit choppy or when you like to cruise at higher speeds. This boat has been used for leisure boating, which suits its character well: a sporty day boat that easily combines an afternoon of cruising, anchoring in a bay, or more active driving.

Hull, handling characteristics and helm position

The V-bottom of this Lamberti Yama 22P7 contributes to a stable and predictable boating experience. In practice, this means the boat responds pleasantly to steering input and is suitable for both relaxed trips and more dynamic boating. Steering is via a steering wheel, which many boaters appreciate for its direct control and familiar feel, especially at higher speeds or when navigating busier waterways. With a draft of around 60 cm, the boat is also suitable for a wide range of inland waters, leaving sufficient margin in shallower areas or when approaching a small beach.

Mercury 200 hp outboard: performance and experience

Mounted on the transom is a 200 hp Mercury outboard engine, electrically started and equipped with six cylinders. This configuration fits perfectly with the sporty profile of a 6.5-metre console boat: you have ample power for brisk acceleration, smooth planing and confident handling when travelling with multiple passengers. The petrol tank has a capacity of 80 litres, providing a practical range for day trips on lakes, waterways and rivers. Onboard instruments include a fuel gauge and tachometer, so you can keep an overview of consumption and engine rpm while underway and easily adjust your speed to comfort and conditions.

On-deck comfort and ease of use

As a console boat, the layout focuses on outdoor living and freedom of movement. The fitted exterior cushions enhance seating comfort during longer trips or when at anchor. For swimmers, there is a swim ladder, making it easy to get back on board after a dip. Also practical are the fenders and lines, which simplify docking and mooring and help protect the boat in a marina or alongside a jetty. The cockpit is self-draining, a feature that adds convenience in changing weather conditions and helps keep the deck clean and dry.

Equipment, safety and maintenance information

In terms of basic equipment, essential items for day trips have been considered. For example, there are two anchors with line attachment, useful when you want to stop for a swim, lunch or to enjoy the view. In addition, there is an electric bilge pump on board, providing extra reassurance for removing any water that may enter. The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025, and the antifouling treatment was carried out in 2024. As with a used console boat, you should expect normal signs of use consistent with recreational use.

Including road trailer with registration: flexible boating and easy transport

A major advantage is that this Lamberti Yama 22P7 is supplied with a road trailer with registration. This makes the package attractive for boaters who like to vary their cruising area, want to store the boat at home, or regularly explore a different lake or river. The trailer is stated to be in good condition, making transport and launching even more accessible.

This Lamberti Yama 22P7 with Mercury 200 hp is therefore an interesting choice for anyone looking for a sporty GRP console boat with strong performance, practical equipment and the freedom of trailering; ideal for leisure boating on inland waters.
