**Nacra 570 MK1 fast catamaran with trailer**  
Anyone looking for a sporty catamaran that invites you to get out on the water more often will find an attractive opportunity in this 2017 Nacra 570 MK1. She is a familiar sight in open catamaran sailing: fast, direct, yet still accessible for sailors who want to develop their skills further. This Nacra has been used for recreational sailing on inland waters and at sea, and she has also taken part in the Round Texel race multiple times. That says a lot about her character: built to make speed, but also to comfortably deliver long, enjoyable days on the water.  
She is built in polyester and measures 5.70 metres in length and 2.44 metres in beam, with a shallow draft of around 20 centimetres. This makes her interesting for those who like sailing in areas with shallows, such as the Wadden Sea or the Frisian lakes. Thanks to her setup as a sport catamaran with twin steering and twin rudders, she feels lively and responds quickly to trim and helm input. Steering is via a joystick, which many cat sailors appreciate for its direct feel.  
**What type of boat is this Nacra 570 MK1?**  
She is an all-round sport catamaran that feels at home both in recreational high-speed sailing and with racing ambitions. The Nacra 570 MK1 is known as a platform on which you can grow with a crew: from relaxed reaches to trapezing and playing with speed and balance. With her blue sails and the white-and-red spinnaker set, she also looks distinctly sporty and on the water she shows why you buy Nacra 570; so often goes hand in hand with the desire to really pick up the pace.  
**Is she ready to sail and what is included?**  
She is offered ready for use via Boatauction, including a road trailer. The trailer is a single-axle Pega with working lights, and it is fitted with a spacious storage box for sails, suits and tools. This is practical for those who want to store, transport and rig the boat quickly on location. A cover is also included to keep her tidy between sailing days. Documentation is partly available, including the purchase invoice and various maintenance documents, although incomplete.  
**What has been done recently?**  
Recently, attention has been given to components that are important on a sport catamaran. The rigging has been replaced not long ago, and both rudder fittings have also been renewed. In addition, she was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. This kind of information is useful for buyers specifically looking for a Nacra 570 MK1 with trailer; and wanting to know what has already been addressed before the season starts.  
**What known points of attention are there?**  
She is in reasonable condition and shows visible use, consistent with a boat that has logged many sailing hours and has also been used to improve catamaran sailing skills. There was a light collision at the bow; this has been professionally repaired. Furthermore, there is a small cosmetic dent in the front beam next to the mast ball, without affecting sailing. The rudder blades have some spots in the protective layer, while the core remains intact. These points are relevant for anyone seeking transparency at a catamaran auction and wanting to know in advance what to expect.  
**Who is this catamaran a good match for?**  
She suits sailors looking for a fast catamaran for sporty sailing on inland waters as well as at sea, and who enjoy using trim, trapeze and possibly a spinnaker to get more out of every gust. For those looking for a proven model with a practical transport solution, this is also an interesting combination: a Nacra 570 MK1 with road trailer and storage box makes it easy to plan a spontaneous sailing day. Anyone searching online for terms such as buy sport catamaran;, Nacra 570 MK1 2017;, catamaran with spinnaker; or Boatauction catamaran; will find in this lot a boat that is ready to bring speed and enjoyment back on the water.
