**Unmatched versatility:** Ideal for regattas (one-design racing in the Gulf of Morbihan), day sailing, or light cruising (cabin with 2 berths).

**Easy maintenance:** Unlike the wooden Guépard, this composite Gazelle requires no caulking or varnishing? just annual polishing and waxing (like new!).
