The Belliere 41 is a highly regarded Bluewater cruising yacht, built in Spain and designed by Peter Ibold. Known for their solid construction and comfortable layout, this 1995 model offers a very practical platform for extended cruising. This vessel has been regularly maintained and has benefitted from a series of upgrades in recent years. Notable improvements include renewed standing rigging (2022), updated battery systems (2023), installation of a water-maker (2024), new oven and new sails between 2024 and 2025. Routine maintenance and technical works have also been carried out, including engine servicing and replacement of key components. The deck layout features a teak cockpit and side decks, with a functional and protected cockpit area equipped with Bimini and sprayhood. The general condition reflects ongoing use combined with excellent periodic maintenance. Inside, the yacht offers a two-cabin layout suitable for cruising. The aft cabin includes a double berth with en-suite facilities, while the forward cabin provides additional sleeping arrangements. A second head is accessible from the saloon. The interior has seen partial updates, including refurbishment work in the forward cabin. The vessel is powered by a Volvo Penta MD22 diesel engine (78 HP) with approximately 2,662 hours, configured with shaft drive and fixed propeller. Overall, this Belliere 41 represents a solid and capable cruising yacht, with recent updates that may be of interest to buyers looking for a vessel prepared for medium to long-distance cruising. **History of the Yacht** "Kismet" has been carefully owned by a Spanish family with a true passion for sailing. She has proven her capabilities across the Mediterranean, on passages to the Canary Islands, before crossing the Atlantic to Martinique, where she spent several seasons cruising the Caribbean. Well maintained throughout, she benefits from key upgrades including a water-maker, wind-generator, new standing rigging, and sails, along with a regularly serviced engine. She represents a unique opportunity for someone looking to continue her legacy—whether for Mediterranean cruising or more ambitious offshore passages.
