KING RANSOM is a 23.16-meter sailing catamaran built by MATRIX in 2007 with outstanding build quality, offering a remarkable balance between volume, performance, and design, far from traditional mass-produced standards.

With a beam of 11.50 meters and a displacement of under 50 tons, it represents a rare opportunity on the market, particularly due to its sought-after layout of 5 double cabins (including owner's suite) plus crew cabins.

The vast panoramic saloon, surrounded by large windows, provides exceptional brightness and an incredible sea view. Directly accessible from the saloon, the full-beam owner's suite with a spa enjoys a unique panoramic forward view, complemented by 4 additional double cabins. The galley on the port passageway is phenomenal, as are the separate crew quarters, ensuring mutual respect between the owner and staff.

The aft cockpit and flying bridge offer comfortable spaces, and its deck plan is optimized and straightforward for ergonomic handling, allowing smooth operation even with a reduced crew, thanks in part to its in-boom furling system.
