The Invader 500 is offered via BoatAuction and includes a road trailer, making her especially interesting for those who like to explore different cruising areas or store the boat easily at home.</p></h3><strong>Invader 500 now in the online auction. Everyone can bid up to and including 22 June 2026.</strong></h3></h3><h3>What makes this Invader 500 so attractive?</h3><p>This Invader 500 combines practical dimensions with a notably powerful propulsion setup. On the transom is an Evinrude outboard engine from 2009 with 140 hp, electric start and four cylinders. That power suits the character of a sporty speedboat and makes her suitable for brisk cruising, watersports and dynamic day use. On board, instruments are present such as a fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and tachometer, so you can keep a clear overview while underway. There is also navigation in the form of GPS, which is convenient when running new routes or simply when you like to keep track of your course and speed.</p></h3><h3>How does she handle and what can you expect from the engine?</h3><p>She is offered with a working engine, and the combination of a 5-metre hull with 140 hp typically results in lively handling. The petrol tank has a capacity of 60 litres and the stated consumption is around 10 litres, making her suitable for a day on the water without constantly having to plan around refuelling stops. The alternator, voltmeter and installed battery support the electrical systems on board. With an interior headroom of around 2.00 metres, the boat offers surprisingly usable space for her length class. This makes it easier to move around on board, grab gear or take shelter when the weather turns. An anchor is included, handy for a break in a quiet bay or along a recreational lake. Anyone looking for a compact motorboat for day trips, short stops and relaxed cruising will find this Invader a logical match.</p></h3><h3>What is known about maintenance and condition?</h3><p>The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. It is also stated that approximately &acirc;&#130;&#108; was spent in 2025 and that she has been used since. No signs of osmosis have been reported, which is an important point of attention for a polyester boat. No known defects have been specified either. Documentation is available in the form of RDW details. All of this provides a clear starting point for a buyer who wants to know where they stand with a used motorboat.</p></h3><h3>What about the trailer and transport?</h3><p>A road trailer is included in the sale. It is braked and has two axles, which is beneficial for stability during transport. The trailer is without registration. For buyers searching for &acirc;&#128;&#156;motorboat with trailer&acirc;&#128;&#157; or &acirc;&#128;&#156;speedboat on trailer&acirc;&#128;&#157;,, this is a practical combination: you can easily transport her to another lake, a holiday destination or winter storage.
