Remarks :

This 2004 Aquastar 38 Aft Cabin is a one owner boat from new and is powered by well minded twin Yanmar 315hp shaft driven diesel engines with only 1250 engine hours approx. Her layout includes twin steering stations, large cabin aft with en-suite, main saloon, dinette further forward with galley opposite, forward cabin and forward heads. Her inventory includes generator, bow thruster, stern thruster, trim tabs, hot water, heating, shore-power, colour chart plotter, radar, auto-pilot, log, depth and much more. "Lynne IV" has oodles of room both on deck and below. She certainly feels larger than her 38 feet might suggest. This boat is in pristine condition and viewing is highly recommended.

Accommodation :

Raised Deck Saloon / Wheelhouse

Helm Station to starboard (Dual steering) with full engine instrumentation and navigation instruments

Sliding door next to helm station giving quick access to the side deck

L-shaped settee (single berth) aft of the helm station to port

Drinks locker/bar opposite to starboard

Upgraded saloon windows, including windscreens with stainless steel frames, giving excellent all round visibility

Engine access via saloon sole (floor)

Four steps up lead out to the aft deck

Dinette / Galley

Forward of the saloon and three steps down leads to the dinette table to port and the u-shaped galley to starboard

The dinette table can drop to form a double berth.

Galley comes complete with stainless steel sinks, hot water, four burner gas cooker with oven and grill, extractor fan, 12v. fridge and loads of storage lockers.

Three opening ports at the port side and two opening ports at the starboard side and an opening deck hatch.

Forward Heads

Comes complete with electric fresh water flush marine toilet, wash hand basin, shower with electric sump pump, hot water, holding tank with deck discharge and 3 way valve and opening port

Forward Cabin

V-berth can convert to a double, shelves, hanging locker, opening deck hatch and two opening ports

Owners Aft Cabin

Large island berth, hanging lockers, shelves, access door to engine bay and four opening ports.

Owners En-Suite

Electric fresh water flush marine toilet, wash hand basin, shower with electric sump pump, hot water, holding tank with 3 way valve and deck discharge and two opening ports

Other

Hot air heating throughout.

Hot water via engine and shore-power

All portholes are stainless steel

Original carpets and curtains in excellent condition

All linings are in excellent condition

The varnished teak interior is in exceptional condition. She had about 15 coats of varnish applied when new and still looks new today.

Owner's Comments

"Lynne IV" was ordered from Aqua Star in Guernsey in late 2003 and we took delivery in May 2004. We brought it back to Ireland for the summer and returned it to Southampton to be exhibited on the Aqua Star stand in September. It wintered in Guernsey for its first service and then returned by sea to Ireland in 2005. Its ideal cruising speed is 15 knots and its top speed is over 20 knots. Full Irish vat was paid in 2004. Since purchasing the boat we have made many trips to the Scilly Isles, south of England and Guernsey. We have cruised the south of Ireland many times up as far as Dingle. She has always been wintered indoors, serviced every year and any work required was immediately carried out. The boat is in very very good condition and the interior is practically in a new state.

"Lynne IV" has spent all her life in the South Coast of Ireland and has been lovingly maintained by her fastidious owners from new. She is a fine sea boat wanting for nothing. The owners are retiring from motorboating hence the reason for selling.
