This light and fast catamaran is designed to deliver exceptional performance.</p><h2>Design and Construction</h2><p>With 30 years of experience in the construction and operation of large catamarans, Claude Kermoal has designed a highly reliable boat. The CK 64 is capable of undertaking a world tour under remarkable safety and comfort conditions. The use of Sealium (a high-performance aluminum alloy) and honeycomb structures for permanent fixtures allows for a tight weight estimate, despite the very comprehensive equipment of this unit.</p><h2>Accommodations</h2>

Four double cabins each with a private bathroom featuring a shower, a large sink, and an electric toilet.

A forward cabin with access via a deck hatch, featuring a double bed, shower, sink, and marine toilet.

A 10 kg washer-dryer.

<h2>Air Conditioning and Water Systems</h2>

Air conditioning in the saloon and cabins: individual air conditioning system.

Chilled water central system.

Hydrotechnical desalinator 280l/h 380V.

Fresh water tanks 2 x 1200 liters in aluminum with gauge.

Hot water circuit with a 50 L water heater in the galley and another 40 L in the starboard cabins.

<h2>Galley</h2>

U-shaped galley.

Double stainless steel sink with hot/cold water mixer on the countertop.

Synthetic stone countertop.

Storage cabinets and drawers.

Professional 3-burner gas cooktop with oven.

Extractor hood outlet, external ventilation.

A Haier 486 L positive cold refrigerator/freezer and 266 L negative cold.

Additional capacity for refrigerator (90 L) or freezer (90 L) in the cockpit.

<h2>Navigation Equipment</h2>

All maneuvers are brought to the cockpit forward of the Fly.

Two 68 ST Antal winches for genoas.

Two Antal 62 ST winches for mainsail.

Two 62 ST winches for reefing.

A 58ST winch in the aft cockpit for mooring and spinnaker or gennaker.

An electric 68 ST winch for mast base and main halyard.

- Electric windlass 2700 w with horizontal gypsy 24 v with wired remote control.
- Main anchor Spade 55 Kg with 14 mm chain 100m.
- Second anchor 45 kg with 14 mm chain 20 m.
- Third anchor 25 kg with 16 mm ropes 50 m.
- Seawater pump for chain and cockpit rinsing (front and rear).
- Remote control for engines and windlass for mooring.

<h2>Cockpit and Exterior Equipment</h2>

- Large aft cockpit protected by the upper deck, with lighting.
- Stainless steel swim ladder accessible for man overboard.
- Complete closure of the aft cockpit.
- Underwater lighting on the stern platform.
- Instrument console at the helm with magnetic compass and electric cable ZF engine controls.
- Diving compressor 14m²/h with five weights, five bottles, mask, and fins.
