Built in 2001 and finished in polyester (GRP), she measures 5.50 metres in length and approximately 2.20 metres in beam. Thanks to her practical centre console, the foredeck sun pad and the included road trailer with registration, this boat suits a wide range of plans: a day out on the water, leisure cruising on lakes, trips on rivers, or a holiday where you want to bring your own boat along. This set is auctioned via BoatAuction and includes the boat, an Evinrude outboard engine and a Pega Euroliner trailer.</p><p>The Rascala Futurama 550 has been used on inland waters, which fits her character: agile, easy to handle and comfortable for a group. With a draught of around 60 centimetres, she can also access many areas with ease. On deck, the bimini and exterior cushions add comfort, while the cockpit cover and the press-stud convertible canopy are practical for protection during transport or when she is not in use. A swim ladder is fitted at the stern, making it much easier to get back on board after a swim or watersports. A cockpit table is also included, allowing the boat to be easily set up for lunch on the water or a long summer evening at anchor.</p><h3>Rascala Futurama 550 now in the online auction. Anyone can bid up to and including 22 June 2026.</h3><h3>How does this Rascala Futurama 550 perform with 115 hp?</h3><p>She is equipped with a 115 hp Evinrude outboard from 2001, with electric start and four cylinders. This power suits a 5.50-metre console boat well: quick acceleration, relaxed cruising and enough punch for more spirited boating. The stated top speed is around 50 km/h, making her suitable for those who enjoy both calm touring and more sporty runs. At the console you will find, among other things, a tachometer and a fuel gauge, so you can keep a close eye on engine load and fuel level while underway.</p><h3>Is she practical for day trips and holidays?</h3><p>Yesâ€”her layout is exactly what makes her attractive for recreational use. The centre console with windscreen provides a comfortable seating position and good visibility, while the space around the console makes it easy to have several people on board. Up front there is a spacious sun pad where you can lie down, or where children often like to sit while cruising. With a built-in petrol tank of approximately 100 litres, you also have a good range for longer days on the water, depending on speed and conditions. This makes the Rascala well suited as a console boat for day trips, but also as a holiday boat for exploring different cruising areas.</p><h3>Whatâ€™s included and what about the trailer?</h3><p>This auction includes a Pega Euroliner road trailer with registration. The trailer is braked, single-axle and described as being in good condition, with major maintenance carried out in 2025. This makes the package especially interesting for anyone looking for a boat with trailerâ€”for example to store her at home, transport her to another cruising area, or easily launch her at a slipway. Because boat and trailer are offered together, you get a complete set that makes logistics quick and straightforward.</p><h3>What is her condition and what is known about maintenance?</h3><p>According to the information provided, the boat is in good used condition, with signs of wear consistent with age and use. She was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. The last antifouling treatment was in 2022. No indications of osmosis or traces of osmosis have been reported.
