She is offered as a complete set via Boatauction, including a working Mercury outboard engine and a compact storage trailer. This keeps the threshold low to put her into use immediately after the auction for an afternoon of leisure cruising, a quiet trip through canals and ditches, or a round over lakes and rivers. The boat is easy to oversee in size, and that is exactly what makes her so convenient: easy to handle, quick to get ready to go, and ideal for anyone who wants to enjoy the water without hassle.</p><p>The With 475 has a length of 4.75 metres and a beam of 1.20 metres. With a draught of around 20 centimetres, she feels at home on shallower stretches and sheltered inland waterways. Her polyester hull is practical in use and suits the character of this type of open boat: step in, start up and go. According to the information provided, there are no indications of osmosis or traces of it, which is an important point of attention for many buyers of a polyester boat.</p><h3>What kind of boat is the With 475 exactly?</h3><p>The With 475 is an open boat aimed at accessible boating fun. She is compact, easy to handle and intended for relaxed trips on inland waters such as lakes, canals and rivers. Thanks to her dimensions, the boat is suitable for those looking for a small boat that is easy to launch and requires little storage space. This makes her interesting as a first boat, as a tender for a holiday home, or as a practical sloop-style open boat for short cruises.</p><h3>How does she run with the Mercury 4 hp outboard?</h3><p>On the transom is a Mercury outboard engine with 4 hp, model ME4M 4 ST, year of manufacture 2000. The engine is stated to be in working order and is started by hand. This type of outboard suits the calm character of the With well: simple, straightforward and ideal for trips where enjoyment matters more than speed. A nice detail is that the set is equipped with an engine lock, which is convenient when she is moored or standing on the trailer.</p><h3>What is included with this auction lot?</h3><p>This Boatauction lot concerns a complete combination: the With 475, the working Mercury outboard engine and a storage trailer. The trailer is compact, single-axle, and described as a storage trailer in reasonable condition. For many buyers this is a major advantage, because after use you can easily take her out of the water and store her at home or at a storage location. Especially with a small polyester boat, such a trailer often makes the difference between boating occasionally and boating often.</p><h3>When was the boat last out of the water?</h3><p>According to the information provided, the boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. This offers a recent reference point for interested parties who like to know when she was last ashore. No date is stated for an antifouling treatment, which can be logical for inland-water use and for a boat that is also regularly kept on a trailer. Anyone planning to leave her in the water more intensively can take this into account.</p><p>The steering position is outside, as befits an open boat in this class. With build number 743, she is also clearly identifiable. The boat has been used for day trips and leisure cruisingâ€”exactly the boating profile this type of With 475 is well suited to. If you are looking for a compact boat with an outboard engine, a polyester open boat for inland waters, or a complete set with trailer for flexible boating and storage, then this lot is well worth a look. She offers an accessible way to get out on the water, with practical equipment that matches relaxed and carefree boating.</p></p>
