The boat has been used for leisure cruising and day trips, which suits her character well: practical, light and focused on enjoying time on the water.</p><h3>Which engine is fitted and how does she handle?</h3><p>She is equipped with a Tohatsu MFS9.8 B3V2 outboard engine of 10 hp, a short-shaft petrol engine with manual start. According to the information provided, the engine is operational and fitted with an outboard lock, which is reassuring during storage or when moored. With 10 hp, this Consoleboat 420 is suitable for relaxed cruising and brisk travel on inland waters. The combination of a compact hull and an outboard engine makes her manoeuvrable, so docking and handling in narrow canals or at busy jetties generally goes smoothly.</p><h3>What equipment is included?</h3><p>This set includes features that make boating more comfortable. The bimini provides shade on sunny days, making longer trips more pleasant. The boat cover allows the boat to be covered when not in use, helping to keep her tidy during storage. The swim ladder makes it easy to get back on board after a dip or a swim stop, which is a big plus on warm days on lakes and ponds. Together, these items ensure the Consoleboat 420 is not only a motorboat to cruise in, but also one to truly spend the day on.</p><h3>Is a trailer included and what does that mean for transport?</h3><p>Yes, she is supplied with a single-axle storage trailer.
