**Lodestar 330 ready for boating fun**  
Anyone looking for a practical inflatable boat with an outboard engine and trailer will find this Lodestar 330 an appealing combination. The boat is compact enough to handle easily, yet offers surprisingly many options for a day on the water. It has been used on inland waters, canals and ditches, as well as on lakes, ponds and rivers. That makes it a great all-rounder for leisure boating, a relaxed cruise through the city, or an afternoon drifting and exploring on more open water.  
This Lodestar 330 has a length of 3.30 metres and a beam of 1.40 metres. With its shallow draft of approximately 10 centimetres, it is ideally suited to shallow stretches and quiet mooring spots rather than approach with a larger boat. Steering is via the outboard, which suits the open and accessible character of this type of boat. The material is listed as other material, fitting the segment of inflatable boats and lightweight recreational craft for which Lodestar is known.

**What makes this Lodestar 330 interesting for you?**  
This inflatable boat is offered as a complete set, so you don't have to gather all kinds of separate parts before you can get on the water. It is equipped with a Garmin fishfinder, making it especially interesting for those who like fishing or simply want more insight into depth and bottom structure while underway. Oars are also included, handy as a backup or for short manoeuvres near the shore. There is also a bow bag for storing items you want within easy reach. The separate fuel tank makes the setup practical to use, especially when you want to empty it easily or transport it after a day of boating.

**Which engine is fitted and what can you expect?**  
The boat is equipped with a Suzuki DF 15A 15 hp petrol outboard engine. According to the information provided, the engine is operational. With 15 hp, this is a power level that suits a 3.30-metre boat well: lively enough for enjoyable cruising and comfortable boating with a few passengers, while keeping everything manageable and accessible. The engine serial number is 140414. For anyone searching for a Suzuki DF 15A outboard engine combined with an inflatable boat, this is a well-known and commonly used match in the recreational segment.

**Is a trailer included and how do you transport it?**  
Yes, a trailer is included with this Lodestar 330. It is a Pega road trailer from 2006, described as a road trailer without registration and fitted with a spare wheel bracket. This means you can move and store it easily, making this set especially attractive for those without a permanent berth or who like to visit different cruising areas. The trailer is stated to be in good condition, which is reassuring if you plan to use it regularly for transport to the water.

**When was the boat last taken out of the water?**  
According to the information, the boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. This is relevant for buyers who want an impression of recent use and the attention it has received. It also provides a logical moment to pay extra attention during an inspection to the general condition, connections and accessories.

**What type of boating is it best suited for?**  
This Lodestar 330 is particularly attractive for day trips and relaxed leisure boating. Think of a loop through canals and ditches, an afternoon on the lake, or a calm trip along a river. Thanks to its compact size, it is also interesting as a beginner's boat, a second boat at a holiday home, or a practical set for anyone who wants to get on the water quickly without hassle. If you're looking for an inflatable boat with outboard engine and trailer, this combination matches what many watersports enthusiasts want: transportable, complete and ready to use.
