Qwest B421 aluminium boat with trailer
Anyone looking for a practical aluminium boat for relaxed trips, a sporty cruise or a day of fishing will find this Qwest B421 an appealing candidate. The boat is 4.20 metres long and 1.60 metres wide, which keeps her easy to handle on narrow waterways while still offering enough space for a few people to sit comfortably on board. Thanks to her shallow draft of around 20 centimetres, she feels at home on shallow lakes, canals and ditches, and she also performs well on larger lakes and rivers. This Qwest has been used on inland waters, making her a great choice for anyone mainly wanting to boat in the Netherlands, from city canals to recreational lakes.

The aluminium hull gives the Qwest B421 a robust, no-nonsense look and suits a boat that is built to be used. Aluminium boats are popular with boaters who want to step aboard and go without worry, which fits the character of this model perfectly. The steering position is outside and the boat is equipped with console controls, making operation clear and contributing to an active, direct boating experience. For fishing enthusiasts, a complete fishing set is also included, making her extra interesting as a fishing boat or as a compact aluminium fishing boat for a spontaneous evening outing.

What makes this Qwest B421 suitable for inland waters?
She combines a compact size with a shallow draft, allowing you to cruise easily through canals, ditches and shallower sections. At 4.20 metres in length the boat is manoeuvrable when docking and turning, while the 1.60-metre beam provides a stable feel on board. This makes her suitable for leisure cruising, a day on the water and sporty use; exactly how she has been used.

Which engine is fitted and what can you expect?
Mounted on the transom is a Suzuki DT 6A outboard engine with 6 hp, in working condition and ready for use. This petrol engine suits the size of the Qwest B421 well and is a logical match for calm cruising, moving between fishing spots and relaxed boating on inland waters. The engine serial number is 00603F-149323. Anyone looking for an aluminium boat with an outboard for recreational use will find a straightforward, accessible combination here; also ideal for boaters who want an easy start.

Is a trailer included and how practical is that?
Yes, she is offered with an Atlanta road trailer without registration. The trailer has a single axle, 13-inch wheels and five rollers, and it is tilting. That tilting mechanism often makes launching and retrieving just a bit easier, especially on slipways where you want to work efficiently. A boat with trailer is also ideal if you want to switch between cruising areas, store her at home, or spontaneously visit another lake or river.

When was the boat last taken out of the water?
According to the information provided, she was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. This is relevant for buyers who want an impression of recent use and the attention given to the boat. With an aluminium boat like this Qwest B421, it is helpful to know when she was last ashore; for example with a view to checking fittings, the engine installation and overall condition.

All in all, the Qwest B421 is an inviting choice for anyone looking for a compact console boat, an aluminium fishing boat, or simply a practical boat for leisure cruising on inland waters. She offers a nice balance between simplicity and functionality, with a working Suzuki outboard engine and a matching tilting trailer.
