Her shallow draft of around 20 centimetres also makes her suitable for shallower stretches and sheltered waters. The steering is positioned externally, which suits the open character of this type of small sloop-style boat. Everything feels straightforward: step aboard, start up and enjoy being outside.</p><h3>What kind of boat is the Texas 360 exactly?</h3><p>The Texas 360 is a compact GRP boat suited to day trips and recreational use. She is designed for simplicity and enjoyment: no complicated systems, but an accessible layout youâ€™ll quickly feel comfortable with. Thanks to her size she is easy to manoeuvre, even if you donâ€™t have much boating experience yet. At the same time, the boat offers enough space for a small group to sit comfortably and to pause underway for a drink or a quick swim stop.</p><h3>Which engine is included and what can you expect?</h3><p>This set includes a Parsun F4BML outboard engine with 4 hp, a four-stroke petrol engine. According to the information provided, the engine is operational, which is reassuring if youâ€™re looking for an outboard suited to calm cruising and relaxed travel on inland waters. A 4 hp outboard is generally a logical match for a boat of this size: enough to get going smoothly and hold course, without turning the boatâ€™s character into â€œrushingâ€. The serial number is listed (V09054455), which is useful for your own records.</p><h3>Is she suitable for canals, ditches and lakes?</h3><p>Yesâ€”this is exactly where the Texas 360 comes into her own. She has been used on inland waterways, canals and ditches, as well as on lakes, ponds and rivers. Thanks to her compact dimensions and limited draft, you can easily navigate narrower passages and cruise along quays. For anyone looking for a boat for a day of boating fun, a short evening trip or low-threshold leisure boating, this type is an attractive choice.</p><h3>What about comfort and equipment on board?</h3><p>The boat is offered with outdoor cushions, which noticeably improves seating comfort on longer trips. A swim ladder is also includedâ€”handy if you like taking a dip or simply want to climb aboard more easily from a jetty. In addition, oars are supplied. Thatâ€™s practical if you want to paddle quietly, as an extra aid when docking, or if youâ€™d like to move without the engine in a quiet canal.</p><h3>What is known about maintenance and condition?</h3><p>The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. According to the information provided, there are no indications of osmosis or traces of osmosis, which can be an important point of attention with GRP boats. The overall condition is described as good.
