Jeanneau Cap Camarat 8.5CC ready for adventure
This 2018 Jeanneau Cap Camarat 8.5CC is a sporty centre-console boat that invites you to head out, whether for a fast afternoon on inland lakes or a relaxed weekend on larger waters. With a length of 8.37 metres and a beam of 2.98 metres, the Cap Camarat offers a pleasantly spacious feel on deck, while her V-hull ensures stable and comfortable cruising. She is built in polyester (GRP) and designed as a true all-rounder: quick to plane, comfortable seating, and still the option to stay overnight on board.

The boat comes from the first owner, who has enjoyed many hours on the water and is now moving up to a larger vessel. She has been used on inland waterways, lakes, canals and rivers, but also at sea. That fits the character of this model: a Jeanneau Cap Camarat 8.5CC is a popular choice for those looking for a sporty speedboat with a practical layout and a modern look.
What makes this Jeanneau Cap Camarat 8.5CC so appealing?
Her combination of space, performance and ease of use stands out immediately. The twin outboard setup gives her the power for sporty cruising while still allowing smooth manoeuvring. Steering is via a wheel at the outside helm position, exactly as you would expect from a centre-console boat. On deck she is set up for enjoying time with friends and family, with exterior cushions, a bimini for shade, and a teak deck that gives a warm, premium appearance. Practical extras include fenders and lines, a cover, and a swim platform with swim ladder for an easy dip or a relaxed break at anchor.
Which engines does she have and what can you expect on the water?
She is equipped with two Evinrude outboard engines of 200 hp each, model year 2018, with electric start and six cylinders per engine. This twin setup perfectly matches the sporty character of the Cap Camarat 8.5CC and provides excellent control, also when docking or turning in tight spaces. Both engines are in working condition. For buyers searching for terms such as Jeanneau Cap Camarat 8.5CC twin outboards, 2x200 hp, or sporty centre-console boat, this is a configuration that often sits high on the wish list.
Is she suitable for day trips as well as weekends away?
Yes, she is clearly set up for both. For day cruising and leisure boating, the deck is spacious and social, with comfortable seating and a pleasant layout for lounging. For a weekend away or short holidays, she offers two fixed berths inside with mattresses. In addition, there are amenities that make staying on board more comfortable, such as a refrigerator, a shower and a manual toilet. This makes her more than just a fast speedboat; she is also a practical weekend boat for those who like to stay on the water longer.
What about navigation and electrics on board?
She is fitted with navigation equipment well suited to both inland waters and coastal use, including a depth sounder, GPS and chartplotter. This makes route planning and navigation clear and straightforward, especially on unfamiliar waters. Shore power is also available on board, together with a battery charger, useful in the marina or alongside a berth. An electric bow thruster further assists manoeuvring, which many skippers appreciate as a helpful extra in wind or confined spaces.
What is known about maintenance and documentation?
Documentation is available in the form of maintenance and purchase receipts. She was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026, and the most recent antifouling treatment was in 2025. It has been stated that there is no osmosis and no signs of osmosis, and no known defects have been reported.
