This Carter has been used on lakes and has logged most of her hours on the Veerse Meer, where, according to the owner, she proved ideal for a day of sailing enjoyment. The boat is offered via Boatauction and will be delivered as a ready-to-sail sailboat with an electric outboard motor, allowing you to immediately enjoy quiet and relaxed boating.

With a draft of about 0.20 metres, the Carter 600 is interesting for shallower areas and sheltered waters. At the same time, she remains a true sailer: a mast, a sail and simple, clear operation. Steering is done with a tiller from the cockpit, which many sailors appreciate for the direct feel of the rudder. The rudder is single, matching the character of a light and agile boat.
What kind of boat is the Carter 600 exactly?
The Carter 600 is a polyester sailboat in the popular segment of compact day sailers. She is intended for recreational use on lakes and inland waters, with simplicity and fun at the centre. Thanks to her dimensions, the boat is easy to handle for those who want to sail without fuss, but also attractive for anyone looking for a second boat for short trips. How does she run with an electric Torqeedo motor?

When was she last taken out of the water?
The Carter 600 was last taken out of the water in 2025 for maintenance. This is relevant information for buyers who pay attention to the overall condition of a boat and when she was last ashore. No date has been provided for an antifouling treatment. No indications of osmosis have been reported, which is often a point of specific interest with polyester boats.
Are there any known points of attention or special features?
No specific defects have been stated and nothing special is mentioned as a point of attention. It is good to know, however, that no documentation is available. Anyone who prefers to have everything on paper should take that into account. At the same time, this type of day sailer is popular precisely with people who mainly want to boat and sail, with straightforward technology and practical equipment.
