This 2005 **Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 40.3** is a well-regarded cruising yacht designed by Daniel Andrieu and built by Jeanneau at Les Herbiers, France. Previously based in Italy, she has been owned by her current Norwegian owners since 2017 and has seen light, seasonal use throughout — typically around five weeks afloat each year, with the remainder of the season spent ashore on hard standing. She is now offered for sale at Cleopatra Marina, Preveza, in good general order, with a number of outstanding items noted at the end of this document still to be resolved before completion.

The Sun Odyssey 40.3 is a practical and well-proportioned cruising design, offering a comfortable three-cabin, two-heads layout suited to a couple or small family exploring the islands. She benefits from a 2023 Raymarine Element 7S chartplotter, a 2021 solar panel installation, an engine serviced in spring 2026 with a new impeller fitted, and six new saloon side windows. A 94m²; gennaker and furling sock, added in 2016, give her useful extra speed downwind.

BROKER'S REMARKS

This is a well-proportioned cruising yacht that will suit a buyer looking for a straightforward, practical boat for island hopping in the Ionian and wider Greek waters. Light use and careful ownership since 2017 mean she presents as a sensible, low-hours package for her age, and the three-cabin, two-heads layout works well for a couple with guests or a small family.

Recent attention to the engine, navigation suite, and energy system — a spring 2026 service and new impeller, a 2023 Raymarine chartplotter, and a 2021 solar installation — all point to an owner who has kept on top of the essentials. The interior is finished to a high standard, with full leather upholstery in very good condition and woodwork that is in exceptional order throughout. The gennaker and furling sock add a useful turn of speed for downwind passages between anchorages.

This is a sensible and practical package for the buyer seeking an easy-to-manage yacht in a well-connected Greek base. Early viewing is recommended.

Accommodation :

The yacht offers comfortable three-cabin accommodation with berths for up to six, suited to a couple or small family. The interior is finished throughout in full leather upholstery, white/cream, in very good condition. Interior woodwork is in exceptional condition throughout. Bedding (sheets, duvets, pillows, and towels) is laundered and included with the vessel.

LAYOUT

The layout comprises three cabins and two heads compartments, a saloon with a fixed central table and centrepiece, a forward-facing chart table, and a galley positioned to suit offshore passage work.

DOMESTIC

The galley is equipped with a hob, oven, and grill (Magma), a cool box, and a refrigerator. Both heads compartments are manually flushed; one heads is fitted with a separate shower, and a stern shower is also available.

HISTORY

This Sun Odyssey 40.3 was built by Jeanneau at Les Herbiers, France, in 2005 to the design of Daniel Andrieu. She was previously registered in Italy before being purchased by her current Norwegian owners. She has had one previous owner before the current ownership.

Under current ownership the yacht has been used on a seasonal basis — typically around five weeks afloat each year, with hard standing for the remainder of the season — and has never been used in charter. She was most recently sailed in 2026, including a cruise towards Albania. No leaks have been reported during the current ownership. Maintenance under current ownership includes an engine service and new impeller (spring 2026), anode renewal (2026), antifouling (2024), a 2023 Raymarine navigation upgrade, a 2021 solar panel installation, and six new saloon side windows (2025). No accidents, groundings, or insurance claims are recorded.
