Crownline 315 SCR sport cruiser with three outboard engines</h2><p>This 2008 Crownline 315 SCR is a sport cruiser that makes you want to start planning long days on the water right away. The boat combines a spacious cockpit with a practical cabin layout, making her suitable both for a fun day trip and for a weekend away with overnight stays on board. With a length of 9.50 metres and a beam of 2.95 metres, she offers a pleasantly stable platform, while the GRP hull provides a modern, low-maintenance foundation. She has been used at sea, which suits her type well: a Crownline built to cruise fast and stay comfortable.</p><p>On board, the focus is on convenience and living space. In the cabin you will find, among other things, a dinette, a refrigerator, microwave and freezer, plus hot water and a shower. With four fixed berths, the Crownline 315 SCR is interesting for couples or families looking for a compact yet fully equipped weekend boat. The freshwater tank of approx. 300 litres and the holding tank of approx. 200 litres support longer stays on board, and the electric toilet does not discharge directly into open water. This also makes her attractive for cruising areas where environmental regulations and comfort go hand in hand.</p><h3>Crownline 315 SCR now in the online auction. Everyone can bid up to and including 24 August 2026.</h3><h3>How does this Crownline 315 SCR perform underway?</h3><p>She is equipped with three Evinrude outboard engines of 300 hp each, with electric start and a six-cylinder configuration. This set-up is aimed at enthusiasts of strong performance and sporty handling. The stated cruising speed is around 50 km/h and the top speed around 100 km/h, placing her in the fast motorboat and performance cruiser category. Instruments such as a fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge and temperature gauge help you keep an overview while underway. For those searching terms like Crownline 315 SCR for sale, sport cruiser with outboards, or fast motorboat 9.5 metres, this is a combination that stands out immediately.</p><h3>Is she suitable for overnight stays?</h3><p>Yes, she is set up for comfortable stays with four fixed berths and amenities you would normally expect on a larger cabin boat. The presence of hot water, a shower and an electric toilet compartment completes the weekend feeling, while galley equipment such as a refrigerator, microwave and freezer makes it easy to arrange food and drinks on board. The dinette also provides a pleasant place to sit inside when the weather turns. Anyone specifically looking for a Crownline cabin boat with berths or a sport cruiser with shower and toilet will find a practical layout here that suits short holidays and spontaneous overnight stays.</p><h3>Which navigation equipment and electronics are on board?</h3><p>She features a package well suited to both coastal cruising and longer trips. On board are AIS, GPS, chartplotter, VHF radio, depth sounder, compass and log/speedometer. This supports route planning, situational awareness and communication underway. Electrically, there is 12V on board, supplemented by shore power, a battery charger and an alternator. This also makes the boat pleasant to use in the marina, for example when you close the cockpit tent and spend the evening on board.</p><h3>What is known about maintenance and the underwater hull?</h3><p>According to the information provided, she was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026, and the antifouling treatment was also carried out in 2026. No indications of osmosis have been reported. This is relevant information for buyers specifically looking for a GRP motorboat without osmosis or a Crownline with recent antifouling. As with any auction lot, it is always wise to form your own impression of the hull, engineering and finish during a viewing.</p><p>Outside, this Crownline 315 SCR offers an inviting cockpit with a cockpit table, exterior cushions and a cockpit tent, allowing you to use the space flexibly: open and sunny or sheltered. The swim platform with swim ladder makes anchoring and swimming even more appealing, and the guardrail contributes to a safe feeling on deck. In addition, an electric bilge pump and a lifebuoy are present.</p><p>This Crownline 315 SCR is offered via BoatAuction
