DESCRIPTION

This 2006 Bavaria 37 Cruiser is a well-presented, privately owned cruising yacht offering a practical two-cabin layout, generous accommodation and a particularly spacious cockpit. With six berths, good storage and a straightforward sail plan, she is well suited to relaxed family cruising and time aboard with friends.

Chota Rani has benefited from considerable maintenance and improvement work under her current ownership. Important recent works include a detailed engine service, saildrive service, gas system servicing, seacock and through-hull servicing or replacement, life raft servicing, a new engine start battery and antifouling completed in July 2026.

The standing rigging was renewed in 2023, while the yacht is also equipped with solar panels, a 2kW inverter, Raymarine navigation equipment, radar, AIS, autopilot, a 100m anchor chain and a useful inventory for extended cruising.

Dry berth is paid until 7 August 2027.

BROKER’S REMARKS

Chota Rani is a particularly appealing Bavaria 37 Cruiser for a buyer looking for a well-equipped yacht that has continued to receive proper care and investment. Her manageable 11.20m length, spacious cockpit and comfortable two-cabin layout make her an excellent choice for relaxed island hopping with family and friends, while six berths provide useful flexibility when guests are aboard.

The current owners have continued to maintain and improve the yacht, with recent attention covering the engine, saildrive, cooling system, gas installation, seacocks and through-hulls, safety equipment and antifouling. Standing rigging was renewed in 2023, and further 2026 improvements include a new engine start battery and replacement windlass remote control.

With a strong cruising inventory, 100m of anchor chain, solar charging and useful navigation equipment, Chota Rani is set up for comfortable and straightforward cruising without a long list of immediate preparation. The added benefit of dry berth fees paid until 7 August 2027 makes this an especially convenient proposition for her next owner.

LAYOUT

Chota Rani has a practical two-cabin layout with additional berths available in the saloon, providing accommodation for up to six. The arrangement offers good privacy for two couples or a family, with a comfortable saloon, separate heads compartment and a practical galley for longer stays aboard.

The galley is equipped with gas and induction hobs, an oven, separate electric grill, twin sinks and refrigerator. Hot water is provided via the engine and shore power, with a pressurised fresh water system. A television is also fitted. The freezer previously located in the starboard locker has been removed by the current owners.

HISTORY

Chota Rani was built and launched in 2006. She was under one ownership from new until being purchased by her current owners and was reported never to have been chartered. The current owners have continued a programme of maintenance and improvement, with particular attention given to the engine and saildrive, heat exchanger, underwater fittings, gas system and safety equipment. Standing rigging was renewed in 2023, while antifouling was most recently completed in July 2026.

The yacht is currently offered with dry berth fees paid until 7 August 2027, providing her next owner with a useful and convenient base in Greece.
