Winner 600 with MerCruiser and trailer

The 1983 Winner 600 is a sporty and versatile motorboat for enthusiasts of speed, watersports and relaxing days on the lake. She combines a compact length of 6 metres with a beam of 2.20 metres, offering a pleasant balance between manoeuvrability and space. Her composite hull is designed for smooth performance and, thanks to the powerful MerCruiser engine, she can reach a speed of approximately 65 kilometres per hour. The boat is being offered through BoatAuction with a road trailer, watersports equipment and various practical amenities.

This Winner 600 has been used for recreational boating on lakes and has provided her owner with many enjoyable outings. She is being sold because there is no longer enough time to use her regularly. For a new owner, this is an attractive opportunity to get straight onto the water with a sporty motorboat suitable for recreational boating, day trips and activities behind the boat.

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What are the main dimensions?

The boat is 6 metres long, 2.20 metres wide and has a draft of 65 centimetres. Her air draft is approximately 2.50 metres. An interior headroom of approximately 3.50 metres is specified, and there is a medium-sized space forward for storing equipment. This storage area is useful for watersports accessories, lines, safety equipment or personal belongings during a day on the water.

The boat is steered from the outside using a steering wheel. She has a single rudder, keeping operation straightforward. Thanks to her relatively compact dimensions, the Winner 600 is suitable for various lakes and mooring locations where manoeuvrability is important.

Which engine is installed in this Winner 600?

The boat is equipped with a 1983 MerCruiser 350 Magnum inboard petrol engine. This six-cylinder engine delivers 350 hp and, according to the available information, has 6,102 operating hours. The engine starts electrically, is operational and is controlled from the exterior helm. The engine has been returned to its original configuration. A new throttle lever and throttle cable have also been installed, contributing to direct and comfortable operation.

The instruments include a fuel gauge, temperature gauge and rev counter. The fuel tank has a capacity of 50 litres. The electrical system includes an alternator and two batteries. During a sea trial or viewing, interested parties can experience for themselves how the engine starts, accelerates and performs underway.

How does she perform and steer?

The owner states that the Winner 600 starts well and cruises smoothly. Her trim has been fully adjusted so that the system stops neatly underneath the swim platform. This was not the case with the previous owner. The adjustment was therefore an important point of attention that has now been addressed. The combination of a deep V-shaped sportsboat hull, a powerful inboard engine and exterior steering makes her suitable for sporty boating and watersports activities.

The boat comes with exterior cushions, fenders and lines. A swim platform is located at the stern, providing easy access to the water. A large four-person inflatable towable, a kneeboard and a surfboard are also included. This makes her immediately appealing to families and groups of friends who enjoy spending their free time actively on the water.

What amenities are available on board?

On board there are two batteries, an electric bilge pump and a manually operated anchor windlass. The anchor is stored with chain and line. The exterior equipment further consists of the cushions, fenders, lines and swim platform mentioned above. The side panels have been renewed and new JBL speakers have been installed, adding an extra dimension to music on board during relaxed cruises.

The former LPG tanks have been removed, along with all associated lines. The anodes have been renewed for use in fresh water. According to the information provided, all gauges are working. These modifications and renewals give the Winner 600 a practical basis for recreational use, with equipment focused on boating, swimming and

watersports.

Are there any points of attention for the buyer?

The known damage is located underneath the swim platform. Two sections have broken off there. This is an important point to consider when assessing the boat and can be examined more closely during a viewing. The broken sections are related to the previous trim adjustment, when the trim system did not stop correctly underneath the swim platform with the previous owner.

Otherwise, according to the information provided, the boat is in good condition. The last time she was taken out of the water for maintenance was in 2024. As with any used motorboat, it is advisable to inspect her carefully during a viewing and assess the engine, hull, electrical system, drive system and trailer personally.

What is included with the boat?

The Winner 600 comes with a 1989 Riba road trailer with registration, a braked tandem-axle model. The trailer has a load capacity of 2,500 kilograms, eight rollers, 16-inch wheels and a trailer winch. It is not tilting. The trailer is approximately 8 metres long and 2 metres wide. According to the information provided, the lighting and other components are in good order.

The trailer is therefore suitable for taking the boat out of the water, transporting her and storing her at home or at another location. The large four-person inflatable towable, kneeboard and surfboard are also included in the sale. The boat and trailer documentation, as well as an inspection document for the trailer, are also available.

Who is this boat suitable for?

The Winner 600 is suited to a buyer looking for a powerful used motorboat for lakes, recreational boating and watersports. Her 350 hp MerCruiser engine provides plenty of power, while her 6-metre length keeps transport and use at different locations manageable. She can be used for relaxed cruises, swimming, listening to music or active boating with a towable, kneeboard or surfboard.

With her sporty character, exterior steering, practical storage space and included trailer, this Winner 600 is an interesting offering for anyone looking for a complete boat package. A viewing provides the best impression of her appearance, the condition of the interior, the operation of the engine and the condition of the hull and swim platform.
