Crown Cruiser 970 for relaxed cruising

Why is this Crown Cruiser 970 interesting?

The 1988 Crown Cruiser 970 is an atmospheric steel motorboat for comfortable cruises on inland waterways, lakes and rivers. With a length of 9.70 metres and a beam of 3.20 metres, she offers remarkably spacious accommodation on board, while her draft of just 0.90 metres provides access to a wide range of cruising areas. This cruiser is suitable for day trips, relaxing weekends and holidays during which you want to stay on board for several days.

The boat has a chine hull and is known for her stable handling characteristics. Her character will appeal to water sports enthusiasts who value comfort, practical facilities and a relaxed cruising speed. The current owner describes her as a delightful, ready-to-cruise boat that can easily be used for days on end. Over the years, she has been used for leisure cruising, weekend trips and holidays on inland waterways, lakes and rivers.

How is the accommodation on board arranged?

Inside, the Crown Cruiser 970 offers a comfortable standing height of approximately 1.95 metres. The layout is designed for comfortable stays, with four permanent berths. The interior includes a dining area, mattresses, a cooking appliance, refrigerator and freezer. This makes her suitable for both short trips and longer stays on the water.

The boat has an electric toilet with a 150-litre holding tank. The toilet waste is not discharged directly into the open water. Fresh water is supplied by a 250-litre water tank. A heater provides additional comfort during cooler days and evenings. The accommodation is complemented by a set of pans, plates, cutlery, cups and glasses. Two mattresses and a television are also included in the equipment.

The sleeping arrangements make this cruiser attractive to a family, a couple or a small group of friends. Thanks to her practical facilities, she can be used as a compact weekend boat, but also as a comfortable holiday cruiser for longer trips.

What engine and cruising characteristics does she have?

The Crown Cruiser 970 is powered by a 1988 inboard Mercedes OM615 diesel engine. This four-cylinder engine delivers 55 hp and has electric starting. According to the seller, the engine is operational and has performed without any problems during use. The engine is known for its quiet character and suits the relaxed way in which this cruiser is intended to be used.

The stated speed is approximately 12 kilometres per hour, both at cruising speed and at maximum speed. Fuel consumption is stated to be around 2 litres per hour. The fuel tank has a capacity of 120 litres. An oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and tachometer are fitted, allowing the main engine parameters to be monitored while cruising.

Steering is by means of a wheel. There are two steering positions, allowing you to steer from inside or outside depending on the weather and conditions. The single rudder system contributes to predictable handling. The combination of her wide hull, chine hull and quiet diesel engine makes her suitable for relaxed cruises where comfort is more important than speed.

Is the Crown Cruiser 970 suitable for longer stays?

Yes, her equipment is specifically geared towards independent stays on board. The boat has a 12-volt electrical system, shore power, battery charger, inverter and solar panels. The two batteries have a combined capacity of 180 Ah at 12 volts. According to the seller, she is self-sufficient and can easily accommodate several days on board without a shore power connection.

The combination of solar panels, refrigerator, freezer, cooking facilities, toilet, heating and a spacious water tank provides this motorboat with a practical basis for longer cruises. The dining area offers a pleasant place to eat together or quietly round off the day. Outside, the bathing platform and bathing ladder provide extra convenience during a stop at a swimming location or on a quiet shore.

What is available on deck?

On deck, the Crown Cruiser 970 is equipped with a bimini top, davits, guardrails, fenders, mooring lines, a

bathing platform and a bathing ladder. The bimini top is approximately three weeks old and provides shelter from the sun and light rain. A new Talamex sun deck is also included, complete with hatch and supports. This creates additional outdoor space for relaxing and enjoying the weather.

All windows are made of aluminium. Fly screens are provided for the open windows. Two made-to-measure pleated screen doors are also included for installation. These facilities are practical on warm days, when fresh air is welcome but insects are best kept outside. The outdoor area is ideal for long summer evenings, breakfast on board or a peaceful moment at anchor.

The equipment further includes two anchors with lines, four fenders and mooring lines. Two garden chairs are also included. For safety, two lifebuoys and a boat hook are provided.

When was the underwater hull last attended to?

The boat was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2026. The antifouling treatment was also carried out that year. This gives the new owner a clear and recent point of reference regarding the inspection and preparation of the underwater hull. The Crown Cruiser 970 has a steel hull and weighs approximately 7,500 kilograms. A trailer is not included in the sale.

The seller states that there are no known defects and that the boat has always cruised comfortably. As with any used boat, we recommend that interested parties inspect her carefully during the viewing day. This will give you an accurate impression of her condition, equipment and the operation of the various systems.

Who would this motorboat be suitable for?

This Crown Cruiser 970 is an appealing choice for water sports enthusiasts looking for a spacious steel cruiser with four permanent berths, modest draft and extensive facilities for independent cruising. She combines a practical layout with a welcoming character and a quiet diesel engine. The boat is suitable for couples, families and friends who primarily want to enjoy their time on the water.

Her self-sufficient character makes her particularly interesting for those who enjoy travelling for several days at a time. You can plan a relaxed route past villages, nature reserves and mooring places without depending on a marina with shore power.
