Hatteras 72 Classic Motor Yacht What type of boat is this Hatteras 72? This 1985 Hatteras 72 is an impressive classic motor yacht with plenty of interior space, a generous layout and a commanding presence on the water. With a length of approximately 22.15 metres, a beam of 5.50 metres and a draft of 2 metres, she offers a combination of comfort and volume that is well suited to extended stays on board. The hull is made of polyester and features a V-shaped bottom. With an approximate weight of 73,000 kilograms, this is an imposing boat that conveys space and stability.

The Hatteras 72 was used as a houseboat and is therefore equipped for long-term stays. She has ten fixed berths, making the boat appealing to a large family, groups travelling together or a buyer who wants to accommodate many guests on board. The interior headroom is approximately 2 metres, giving the living areas a spacious feel and allowing taller people to move around comfortably.

Inside, she has a practical and inviting living area with a dining area, refrigerator, freezer, cooking appliance, oven and microwave. The air conditioning on board adds to the comfort during warm days, while the mattresses are suitable for overnight stays on board. The layout makes this Hatteras appealing not only as a classic motor yacht for holidays, but also as a liveaboard or floating residence.

The boat has an electric toilet. According to the information provided, the toilet discharge flows directly into open water. The accommodation provides a good basis for anyone wishing to adapt her further to their own taste. The crew quarters in particular require attention. The cabins would benefit from refurbishment and the toilet should be replaced. At the same time, this gives a buyer the opportunity to modernise the interior according to their personal preferences and adapt the layout to their intended use.

Which engines does the Hatteras 72 have? This Hatteras 72 is powered by two Detroit Diesel 12V71 turbo diesel engines. Both engines are installed and each has twelve cylinders. According to the available information, both engines are operational and start electrically. The engines date from 1985 and suit the character of this robust American motor yacht.

The fuel capacity is approximately 7,000 litres, allowing for a generous range on longer trips. The stated cruising speed is approximately 10 kilometres per hour. On board, instruments are available for temperature, oil pressure, engine speed and fuel level. For a viewing or sea trial, it is advisable to have the engines, propulsion system and technical systems assessed by a qualified professional, as is customary with a classic yacht of this size and age.

What technical points requiring attention are known? The boat is in reasonable condition and has a number of tasks that the new owner can include in their maintenance plans. The wiring of the electric windlass needs to be reconnected. In addition, the bilge pumps and shower drain pumps should be inspected. The Kohler generator set requires servicing. These points are important to take into account during the assessment and bidding process.

The last known maintenance service during which the boat was taken out of the water took place in 2022. The antifouling was also applied that year. No osmosis or signs of osmosis have been reported. Maintenance invoices for the engines are available, giving the buyer additional information about the boat's technical history. As with any used boat of this size, an independent inspection on board is recommended.

What is available for navigation and outdoor living? For navigation, she is equipped with a Raymarine Element 9, a compass, GPS and a chartplotter. The electrical system supports 12, 24 and 220 volts. There are three batteries with a stated total capacity of 36, as well as a battery charger. The hydraulic windlass operates one anchor with chain. This equips the boat for practical anchoring during stays at sea and in sheltered

waters.

Outside, the Hatteras 72 offers plenty of space to relax. She has a bimini, cockpit table, outdoor cushions, swimming platform and swim ladder. There are also pulpit and stern seats, guardrails, fenders and mooring lines. The outdoor area invites you to spend long days on the water, enjoy relaxed meals in the cockpit and swim from the swimming platform.

Who is this Hatteras 72 suitable for?

This Hatteras 72 for sale is particularly interesting for a buyer looking for a spacious classic motor yacht with strong liveaboard potential and plenty of possibilities. She can serve as a comfortable accommodation boat, a base for longer voyages or a distinctive family boat for holidays at sea. Her generous fuel tanks, twin diesel engines and extensive accommodation give her a versatile character.

The boat has been used at sea and, thanks to her size, offers ample space for guests and extended stays. At the same time, she requires attention to several technical and cosmetic points, particularly concerning the crew quarters, the pumps, the electrical connection of the windlass and the generator set. For someone who wants to improve her step by step, this Hatteras 72 provides an interesting basis with a warm, classic appearance and considerable potential.
