gib'sea 242 for relaxed days of sailing

what kind of boat is the gib'sea 242?

the gib'sea 242 is a compact polyester cabin sailing boat from 1987, built by gilbert marine. with a length of 7.37 metres, a beam of 2.49 metres and a draught of 1.60 metres, she is suitable for a wide range of inland waters in the netherlands. the boat combines practical dimensions with the atmosphere and possibilities of a true cabin sailing boat. thanks to her round-bilged hull and light character, she gets up to speed easily, even in light winds.

this gib'sea 242 is an interesting option for sailors who want to head out on the water independently, as well as for families or couples looking for a comfortable boat for day trips and short stays on board. she offers four fixed berths and has approximately 1.70 metres of headroom inside. this makes her an attractive choice for anyone looking for an affordable second-hand sailing boat that offers both good sailing performance and shelter.

how does this polyester cabin sailing boat sail?

the gib'sea 242 is known as a light and pleasant sailing boat. her sail plan consists of a mainsail, jib, genoa and storm jib, allowing her to be used in various wind conditions. she accelerates readily in light winds, making her suitable for relaxed trips on lakes, ponds, canals and other inland waterways in the netherlands.

the boat is steered from the cockpit using a tiller. this provides direct contact with the rudder and creates a lively feeling while sailing. the single-rudder configuration suits the boat's straightforward character. both novice sailors and more experienced watersports enthusiasts can therefore get to know her easily and trim her according to their preferences.

the aluminium mast and four sails provide a versatile basis for different types of sailing trips. the sails are in reasonable condition. as with any used sailing boat, a prospective buyer is advised to inspect them carefully during a viewing.

what accommodation does she offer on board?

inside, the boat has a cosy cabin with a dining area, cooking stove and mattresses. the four fixed berths make her suitable for a weekend on the water or a multi-day trip with two people or a small family. her interior is practically laid out and, according to the available information, is in good condition.

a 20-litre water tank is available for the water supply. she also has a manual toilet. the toilet discharge does not flow directly into open water. there is no heating, which makes this gib'sea 242 particularly attractive for use in spring, summer and early autumn.

the cabin provides shelter during a rain shower and offers a pleasant place to eat together, relax or plan the next day's route. Outside, the polyester cockpit tent adds to the comfort on wet days. it makes the cockpit more usable when the weather changes and provides extra shelter during stays on board.

what engine and electrical facilities are available?

for propulsion, the gib'sea 242 has a single 2005 yamaha outboard engine. the engine has an output of 8 hp, two cylinders and electric start. it runs on petrol and, according to the information provided, is operational. the outboard provides sufficient assistance when manoeuvring in harbours, in light winds and when motoring through narrow or busy waterways.

the boat is equipped with both 12-volt and 220-volt systems. an inverter and shore power connection make it possible to use the electrical facilities on board conveniently when she is moored at the jetty. in 2021, the electrical installation was completely renewed, both for the 12-volt system and for 220 volts. this is an important part of her recent usage history.

what navigation and safety equipment is included?

various navigation instruments are available on board. the equipment includes a depth sounder, compass, log and speedometer, and wind meter. this enables the crew to better monitor their course, speed, depth and wind conditions while sailing. the combination is well suited to use on inland waters, where awareness and good preparation are important.

for safety, she has a

lifebuoy, a manual bilge pump and a self-draining cockpit. A guardrail system is fitted around the boat. there is also a bathing ladder, pulpit and pushpit seats, fenders and lines. the boat is supplied with two anchors, which are secured with rope. there is no anchor windlass.

what recent work has been carried out on the boat?

the gib'sea 242 was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. the antifouling treatment was also carried out that year. she was additionally fitted with completely new striping in 2025, giving her exterior a fresh and well-maintained appearance.

according to the information provided, no signs of osmosis have been identified. no known defects have been reported either. as is customary with a boat auction, we advise interested parties to inspect her thoroughly themselves and check the engine. The condition of used sails, systems and the interior is best assessed on site.

who is this gib'sea 242 suitable for?

this second-hand gib'sea 242 is suitable for watersports enthusiasts looking for a complete and straightforward cabin sailing boat for inland waters in the netherlands. she is large enough for comfortable day trips and short holidays, while remaining compact and easy to handle in smaller marinas. her light sailing characteristics make her accessible to beginners, while the available sails and navigation equipment also offer experienced sailors plenty of possibilities.

the boat has been used for day trips and recreational sailing on inland waters. with her four berths, cooking facilities, cockpit tent and engine, she can be used immediately for relaxed trips. a trailer is not included, so a permanent berth or other transport to the sailing area will need to be arranged.
