What makes this Quicksilver 470 attractive?

This Quicksilver 470 is a versatile polyester motorboat for those who enjoy taking to the water independently. It combines a practical layout with compact dimensions, an outboard engine and an included road trailer. This makes it suitable for day trips, relaxed coastal cruises and weekends on the water. Thanks to its trailer, the boat can also easily be transported to a different cruising area.

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What type of boating is it suitable for?

It has been used for leisure boating, days on the water and short weekend trips. The boat has mainly been used at sea, making it suitable for relaxed coastal cruises and recreational use around an island. Its open and practical character is well suited to sunny days, swimming, having a picnic on board or taking a trip with family and friends.

According to the information provided, the capacity is five people. There is one fixed berth available for overnight stays. In addition, a double cabin and two berths are mentioned. The available interior space is primarily suitable for a short overnight stay or as a sheltered area during a trip. It is less intended for longer stays, but for a weekend on the water it offers an attractive combination of freedom and comfort.

What engine and performance does the boat have?

The Quicksilver 470 is powered by a Mercury four-stroke outboard engine with an output of 50 hp. The engine runs on petrol and, according to the information provided, has approximately 200 operating hours. The stated cruising speed is around 18 knots, depending on the load, weather conditions and water conditions.

The combination of a lightweight polyester hull and this engine provides lively handling. It is suitable for relaxed cruising, while also offering sufficient power to travel quickly to the next bay or mooring. According to the specifications, the fuel tank has a capacity of 50 litres.

What equipment is included?

The boat is equipped with a swimming ladder, making it easy to go swimming and climb back on board. A bimini top is also mentioned, along with summer and winter covers. These covers help protect the interior and seating when the boat is not in use. The electrical equipment on board includes a battery charger.

Radar and a compass are listed for navigation. The operation, condition and presence of the individual items of equipment can be checked during a viewing. The equipment is in keeping with the recreational character of this Quicksilver and provides a practical basis for short trips. The combination of a swimming ladder, covers and navigation equipment makes it an interesting option for water sports enthusiasts looking for a complete, compact motorboat.

Is the trailer included?

Yes, the Quicksilver 470 is supplied with a road trailer for transport by road. According to the information provided, the trailer is in good condition. It is therefore an important part of the lot, as the boat is not tied to a single permanent berth. In principle, the buyer can transport it to different cruising areas, provided that the towing vehicle, weight limits and required documentation are suitable.

The trailer comes from a specialised shipyard and trailer package associated with this Quicksilver. During the viewing, check the tyres, lights, winch, rollers, brakes and other components. It is also advisable to check that the trailer is suitable for the towing vehicle being used and that the boat rests correctly on the supports.

What is the condition of the boat?

The boat is described as being in good condition and having been little used. A usage history of approximately 200 engine hours is stated. The last maintenance service carried out out of the water took place in 2026. The antifouling treatment was also last carried out in that year. This information provides a recent overview of the work performed on the underwater hull, but an independent inspection remains important.

Its polyester hull is suitable for recreational use on inland waters and along the coast. During a viewing, the hull, transom, bottom, engine mounting,

deck components and interior can be examined in greater detail. Attention should also be paid to starting the Mercury outboard engine and checking the operation of the battery charger and navigation equipment. The available documentation is listed as present with the lot, allowing the buyer to review the technical and ownership details further.
