spacious Target 10m for relaxed cruising

The Target Cruiser 1000, also referred to as the Target 10m, is a spacious steel motorboat from 1973 with an inviting appearance and a practical layout. With a length of 10 metres, a beam of 3.20 metres and a V-shaped hull, she offers plenty of comfort for relaxed cruises, holidays and weekends on the water. The boat has been used on inland waterways, lakes, ponds and rivers and, thanks to her clear controls and generous living space, feels at home on a wide variety of cruises.

As soon as you step aboard, the woodwork, saloon and comfortable interior create a pleasant atmosphere. The Target was designed for longer stays and has four permanent berths, with room for two additional sleepers. This makes her suitable for a family, a couple who enjoy taking guests along or water sports enthusiasts who want to spend several days on board.

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What makes this Target 10m attractive?

Her combination of space, practical facilities and a renewed propulsion system makes this motorboat an interesting option for enthusiasts of classic cruisers. The saloon provides a cosy place to eat together or relax, while the separate cabin with two single berths offers additional privacy. There is also ample sleeping space in the forward cabin. The interior headroom is approximately 1.90 metres, making the boat comfortable to access even for taller people.

The accommodation further includes a dining area, refrigerator, cooking appliance and mattresses. There is plenty of storage space for clothing, provisions and boating equipment. The electric toilet adds to the comfort on board. The toilet discharge runs directly overboard. A potential buyer is advised to check the applicable legislation and local regulations before using the boat in specific cruising areas.

What is the engine installation like?

The Target is powered by a single inboard Mitsubishi S4S diesel engine from 2009. This four-cylinder engine delivers 64 hp and has electric start. The engine is fitted with a hydraulic reverse gearbox and, according to the information provided, has 1,376 operating hours. The engine is in working order. Major engine maintenance was carried out by a boat mechanic in 2026, and a new fuel tank was also installed. Documentation is available with the boat, including maintenance information and an invoice relating to the overhauled engine.

The engine compartment is equipped with the usual gauges, including a fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and rev counter. The combination of diesel power, 64 hp and a stable steel hull is well suited to calm and controlled cruising on inland waterways, rivers and lakes.

How comfortable is she during a boating holiday?

The boat has been fitted out with staying on board in mind. In addition to the berths, there is a galley, dining area, refrigerator and cooking appliance. The saloon forms the central living area and provides shelter during less sunny moments. A cockpit canopy and bimini provide additional ventilation and comfort. At the stern, the swimming platform and bathing ladder offer easy access to the water.

The dual steering positions are a practical advantage. They make it possible to steer from both inside and outside, depending on the weather and conditions. The electric bow thruster assists with manoeuvring in harbours, berthing and turning in confined spaces. This also makes the Target easy to handle in smaller marinas.

What equipment is available for longer cruises?

In terms of power supply, the boat is equipped with shore power, a battery charger, alternator, inverter and solar panel. The onboard electrical system operates at 12 volts. On deck, there is an anchor with chain and a manual windlass. Fenders and lines are also included, meaning that the boat has the basic equipment required for mooring. A lifebuoy is on board for safety, while the electric bilge pump helps keep the bilge dry.

The Target has a single rudder system and is steered with a wheel. The air draft is approximately 3.50 metres and the draught around 1.20 metres. These dimensions are important when planning

routes involving bridges, locks and shallower waterways. A trailer is not included; the boat is intended to be used from a berth.

What is the current condition of the boat?

The Target is in reasonable condition and, according to the consignor, has been maintained with care. The most recent stated maintenance carried out out of the water took place in 2023, as did the last antifouling treatment. In addition, work was carried out on the engine in 2026 and a new tank was installed. As with any used boat, it is advisable to inspect her in person before purchase and, if desired, have her examined by a qualified expert.

This classic steel cruiser offers an excellent basis for relaxed boating pleasure. She combines a spacious layout with six berths, inside and outside steering positions, a diesel engine and facilities for staying on board. Anyone looking for a Target 10m motorboat for holidays, weekend cruises or peaceful days on the water will find a charming and versatile candidate in this boat. Through Boat Auction, she could become an interesting next step for a new owner who wants to give her many more hours on the water.
