Compromis 720 Alcione cabin sailing yacht

What kind of boat is this Compromis 720?

This Compromis 720 is a charming cabin sailing yacht from 1970, built by Zaadnoordijk to a design by Rinus Zaadnoordijk. It is considered a predecessor of the later Compromis 720 and was originally known as the Alcione. With its classic round-bilged hull, wooden mast and practical layout, it is an interesting sailing boat for enthusiasts of characterful yachts and water sports enthusiasts looking for an affordable boat for inland waters.

The hull is made of polyester and has a length of approximately 7.20 metres. Its beam is 2.52 metres and its draught is around 0.90 metres. This makes it suitable for use on many Dutch lakes, canals and waterways. The stated air draft is approximately 10.20 metres. Inside, it offers headroom of around 1.77 metres, which is comfortable for a cabin sailing yacht of this size. The boat weighs approximately 1,500 kilograms.

Is this a suitable sailing boat for beginners?

The Compromis 720 can be an attractive choice for someone who wants to get acquainted with sailing at a relaxed pace or is looking for a compact cabin yacht for leisurely trips. Its exterior tiller steering is direct and easy to understand, while the sail plan with a jib and mainsail remains straightforward. The mainsail is equipped with reefing ties, allowing the sail area to be adjusted to changing conditions.

She is particularly suitable for recreational sailing on inland waters. Think of day trips, weekends aboard and short holidays where peace, atmosphere and independent sailing are central. Thanks to her size, she is easier to manoeuvre and maintain than a larger cabin yacht. At the same time, a boat from 1970 requires attention, technical inspection and an owner who is willing to roll up their sleeves.

What is the layout like on board?

Inside, this Compromis 720 has a practical cabin with two fixed berths. For those travelling with several people, there are also two additional berths. This provides sleeping accommodation for up to four people in total, depending on the amount of luggage and the level of comfort desired.

The cabin is compact but suitable for simple stays on board, and a toilet is present. There is no heating. This makes her particularly suitable for day trips and short stays where shore-based facilities are used. The combination of a polyester hull, wooden mast and classic cabin layout gives her a warm, traditional appearance that appeals to many enthusiasts of older sailing yachts.

Which work deserves attention?

According to the available information, the boat is in reasonable condition and requires some cosmetic attention. The paint shows blistering and the running rigging is outdated. There is also fouling present and the cabin doors do not close properly. A thorough cleaning, removal of the fouling and inspection of the underwater hull are therefore advisable before she is used intensively again.

The last maintenance carried out out of the water took place in 2022. Antifouling was applied in the same year. &Amp;nbsp;With a boat of this age, it is advisable to have the hull, through-hull fittings, fastenings, mast step, standing rigging, rudder system and deck hardware carefully inspected before putting her into service. The outdated running rigging also needs to be replaced or at least thoroughly inspected. The cabin doors may be able to be adjusted or repaired, depending on the condition of the woodwork and locking mechanisms.

What is included with this cabin sailing boat?

There are two sails on board: a jib and a mainsail. The sails are in reasonable condition and provide a usable basis for further trips. She also comes with an anchor with chain and line, a cover, fenders and lines. A dinghy, trailer and engine are not included. The boat is therefore intended for use as a sailing yacht and will require additional equipment for independent manoeuvring in harbours or in windless conditions.

The mast is made of wood and, like the rest of the rigging, requires regular inspection. Before setting off, check the condition of the woodwork, fittings, standing rigging and sails. With the right

care, this classic polyester sailing boat can be prepared for relaxed sailing seasons once again.

Who might be interested in the Compromis 720?

This Compromis 720 for sale is particularly interesting for a practical-minded water sports enthusiast, restoration enthusiast or beginning sailor looking for a cabin yacht with character and prepared to undertake some refurbishment work. She offers an excellent basis for someone who values traditional styling, straightforward sail handling and a compact but practical cabin.

Anyone willing to invest time in cleaning, painting, replacing the running rigging and carrying out general checks will have the opportunity to improve her step by step according to their own wishes. The auction through BoatAuction therefore offers a chance to acquire a characterful sailing boat for inland waters, with a clear history and an attractive size.
