This 1994 Chris Craft Crowne 262 is a stylish and sporty motorboat for enthusiasts who enjoy comfortable cruising, weekend trips and longer boating holidays. With a length of 8 metres, a beam of 2.50 metres and a draught of 90 centimetres, she combines a spacious appearance with practical dimensions for many inland waterways, lakes, waterways and rivers. The boat has a polyester hull with a V-bottom and is known for her direct handling. 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How does the boat handle?

The Chris Craft Crowne 262 is powered by a single eight-cylinder Volvo Penta engine from 1994. This inboard petrol engine delivers 305 hp and is electrically started. According to the information provided, the engine is operational. The combination of her V-bottom and powerful engine provides a direct and sporty boating experience. The stated cruising speed is 12 kilometres per hour, while her maximum speed is approximately 55 kilometres per hour.

The boat is steered from the outside via a steering wheel. She has a single rudder and is equipped with a clear set of instruments, including a fuel gauge, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and tachometer. Her fuel tank has a capacity of 150 litres. The stated fuel consumption is 7. For manoeuvring and everyday use, the boat offers a practical and well-organised helm station with good visibility of the waterway.

Is the Chris Craft suitable for overnight stays?

Yes, she has two fixed berths and is equipped for comfortable short stays on board. Inside, there is a dining area, mattresses, a refrigerator and a cooker. The headroom inside is approximately 1.90 metres, making the interior comfortably accessible for most users. The interior upholstery is approximately three years old and gives the interior a well-maintained, homely atmosphere.

The boat is also practically equipped in terms of sanitary facilities. She has a manual toilet, a shower, a 75-litre freshwater tank and an equally sized 75-litre holding tank. The toilet discharge does not flow directly into open water. This means that the Chris Craft Crowne 262 offers a complete basis for weekend getaways, boating holidays and relaxing nights in a marina or at a quiet mooring.

What equipment is included on board?

The boat is supplied with equipment suited to comfortable recreational cruising. On deck, you will find a bimini top, cockpit tent, cockpit table, boat covers, fenders and lines. The swimming platform and swimming ladder make it easy to take a dip or relax at the stern. The cockpit is self-draining, which is convenient in changing weather conditions and when cleaning the exterior area.

For her electrical systems, she has shore power, a battery charger, an alternator, an inverter and a voltmeter. There are three batteries with a total capacity of 100 Ah. The electrical installation operates on 12 and 220 volts. The boat is also equipped with an electric bilge pump, one anchor with line and the usual equipment for safe and enjoyable boating. This combination makes her suitable for recreational boaters who want to get on the water immediately with a complete sports cruiser.

When was the maintenance carried out?

The Chris Craft Crowne 262 was last taken out of the water for maintenance in 2025. The most recent antifouling treatment was carried out in 2026. An engine logbook is available with the boat, allowing the buyer to access relevant information about the engine.

As with any used boat, we advise interested parties to

take their time viewing her during an inspection. This allows you to form your own impression of the engine, interior and systems on board.

Who is this motorboat suitable for?
