Wellcraft 233 Eclipse with trailer

The 1987 Wellcraft 233 Eclipse is a sporty polyester speedboat measuring 7.01 metres in length, 2.01 metres in beam and approximately 85 centimetres in draft. She combines a spacious open cockpit with a powerful inboard engine and is offered together with a braked road trailer. Over the past year, the boat has been used for day trips on inland waterways and is being sold because the current owner no longer has enough time for her.

The Wellcraft has a classic appearance that suits her year of construction. At the same time, various components were repaired or renewed in 2026. This provides a clear basis for someone who wants to complete and technically refine her further. During the viewing day, you can take your time inspecting the boat and assess the condition of the hull, cockpit, engine compartment, trailer and included equipment yourself.

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What makes this Wellcraft interesting?

The 233 Eclipse is a spacious speedboat for day cruising. Her length provides ample room for relaxed trips with family or friends, while the wide open cockpit is suitable for spending time on the water in good weather. A new Flexiteak deck has been installed at the stern. The white leather cushions are intact and contribute to the classic appearance of the interior and seating areas.

The boat is equipped with a bathing platform, a five-step bathing ladder and a guardrail. A cockpit tent, fenders and lines are also included. The boat cover was renewed in 2026 and, according to the information provided, represents a value of approximately €3,900. She is also supplied with four Jobe fenders and matching ropes.

What engine is installed in the boat?

The Wellcraft is equipped with an OMC Cobra V8 inboard engine with a displacement of 5.7 litres. The engine has eight cylinders, an electric starting system and a stated output of 265 hp. The engine was built in 1995 and the meter shows approximately 170 operating hours. She runs on petrol and is cooled and operated from the engine compartment in the stern.

According to the seller, the engine starts and runs. However, the carburettor must be replaced. A new carburettor has already been purchased but still needs to be installed. After installation, the engine will require further adjustment. This is an important point of attention for you as a buyer and requires technical completion before you can use her to her full potential.

Several components around the engine were renewed at the beginning of 2026. These include the starter motor, alternator, V-belts, oil filter, fuel filter and spark plugs. A new battery was also installed in March 2026. The engine compartment deserves extra attention during the viewing day, particularly with regard to fitting the new carburettor and carrying out the subsequent adjustment.

What recent work has been carried out on the boat?

In 2026, the boat was taken out of the water for maintenance. The hull received new antifouling and a Gelshield treatment. She was also professionally polished and given a wax sealant. The bilge pump was renewed in August 2026. The stainless-steel five-step bathing ladder was also newly installed. The table was repainted, and the interior and seating area were professionally cleaned.

The boat cover was fitted in June 2026. The Flexiteak deck at the stern was also renewed during that period. These works give the boat a well-maintained foundation, although it remains advisable to carefully check all finishes, fastenings and connections yourself during the viewing day.

What points require attention?

In addition to the carburettor still needing to be installed, the engine must be adjusted further after installation. Some of the gauges on the dashboard also need to be reconnected. You can inspect the operation of the other instruments and electrical connections during the viewing day. The boat has a battery charger, alternator, voltmeter and shore-power connection. One battery is present, with a stated capacity of 12 volts.

The seller describes the overall condition of the boat as good. As with any used boat in this

age category, it is advisable to take normal signs of use and any work that may become apparent when putting her back into service into account. You can assess the available documentation, technical components and finish yourself during the viewing day.

Is the trailer included?

Yes, the Wellcraft is supplied with a braked, twin-axle road trailer. The trailer was built in 1989 and has a load capacity of 1,800 kilograms. According to the information provided, it underwent extensive work in February 2026. Among other things, the brakes, tyres and handbrake were renewed. The flywheel was also replaced, and the trailer was inspected according to BOVAG standards.

The trailer makes it possible to store the boat ashore or transport her by road, provided that the total weight and towing vehicle are suitable for this purpose. During the viewing day, check the condition of the frame, rollers, lighting, winch and coupling.

Who is she suitable for?

This Wellcraft is suitable for you if you are looking for a classic speedboat with plenty of power, a spacious cockpit and a trailer. She may be of interest to someone who enjoys working on technical projects and wants to arrange or supervise the remaining carburettor and engine-adjustment work themselves. Anyone searching online to buy a boat should pay particular attention to the combination of age, engine power, recent renewals and outstanding work on this model.

This Wellcraft may also be worth viewing for someone looking to buy a second-hand boat and who values a trailer, a new boat cover and a sporty layout. In this case, boat-buying advice mainly means taking the engine-related points of attention seriously in your assessment and estimating the total costs of installation and adjustment in advance.

The boat is being offered through BoatAuction. There is a dedicated viewing day during which you can inspect her. Take the time on that occasion to carefully assess the hull, cockpit, upholstery, cover, engine compartment, instruments, electrical system and trailer.
