What kind of boat is the Shetland Sheltie?

This 1985 Shetland Sheltie is a compact motorboat measuring 5.35 metres in length and 2.05 metres in width. Its composite hull has a V-shaped bottom and a draught of approximately 30 centimetres. This makes it suitable for inland waterways, lakes, ponds and rivers. The boat has been used for day trips, sporting outings, holidays and weekends on the water.

The Sheltie is steered from the outside using a steering wheel. It has an additional helm seat, providing room for several passengers during a trip or fishing day. Inside, the headroom is limited to approximately 50 centimetres. The boat is therefore primarily designed for outdoor boating and short stays on board, rather than extended stays with plenty of interior space.

The boat is equipped with a cockpit canopy, a bimini top and a summer cover. The bimini top was installed in 2024. A winter cover is also included. The exterior equipment further consists of fenders, lines, a bathing ladder and a self-draining cockpit. There are two bathing ladders. Additional rod holders and an extra boat seat are also included in the auction lot.

What engine powers this boat?

The Shetland is powered by a 2007 Yamaha 50 hp EFT outboard engine. It has four cylinders, electric start and approximately 360 operating hours. According to the available information, the engine is in working order. An oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and tachometer are available for inspection during the viewing.

Fuel is carried in two Yamaha petrol tanks, each with a capacity of 30 litres. The stated fuel consumption is approximately 7 litres per hour. The cruising speed is around 22 kilometres per hour, while the maximum speed is approximately 38 kilometres per hour. These figures depend on the load, weather conditions and the state of the water.

The boat has an alternator and a voltmeter. There are two batteries on board and the system operates at 12 volts. An automatic electric bilge pump is installed. Two anchors are available for anchoring, with approximately 100 metres of anchor line and 3 metres of chain. The anchoring equipment is operated using an electric windlass. Mooring lines and an anchor ball are also included.

What navigation and fishing equipment is available?

For navigation and fishing, the Sheltie is equipped with Lowrance equipment. On board are a depth sounder, fishfinder, GPS and chartplotter. The Lowrance navigation system has an NMEA cable. There is also a VHF radio pre-installation with cable and antenna. The available equipment makes this boat appealing to anyone who enjoys recreational boating and fishing.

Safety equipment includes a lifebuoy, two life jackets and the electric bilge pump. The boat has a practical, open layout primarily intended for daytime boating.

What condition is the boat in?

According to the information provided, the boat is in good used condition. The last maintenance service carried out out of the water took place in 2026. The antifouling was also applied that year. According to the owner, the boat was taken out of the water every winter and stored indoors. It was also waxed annually, and the engine received annual servicing.

Some superficial crack lines are known to be present. These are expressly mentioned so that you can form a careful impression of its current condition yourself during the viewing day. The boat was inspected and serviced three years ago. An invoice is available for this work. The owner's description states that the boat was previously used on the Western Scheldt and has sailed on various inland waterways and other calm boating areas over the past three years.

What is included with this Shetland?

The boat comes with a Riba road trailer with registration. The trailer has one axle, a braked configuration, seven rollers and a load capacity of 1,500 kilograms. It measures approximately 6.00 metres in length and 2.20 metres in width. It is equipped with a trailer winch and fourteen-inch wheels. The trailer is not tilting.

Major

maintenance has been carried out on the trailer, with a stated value of approximately €1,000. The trailer forms part of the auction offering. Additional rod holders, an extra boat seat, a winter cover and a summer cover are also included. The available documents include a deregistration certificate and a copy of the registration. The boat will be deregistered from the Belgian register on 1 October.

Is this a suitable boat for you?

The Shetland Sheltie is suitable for you if you are looking for a compact motorboat for day trips, fishing, swimming and relaxing on sheltered waters. Its shallow draught makes it possible to reach more shallow areas. The open cockpit, bimini top and available safety equipment provide a practical layout for summer outings.

Anyone searching online for tips on buying a boat would do well to pay attention during the viewing day to the hull, the superficial crack lines, the engine, the electrical installation and the condition of the trailer. If you are looking to buy a second-hand boat, this lot offers a complete package consisting of a boat, engine, equipment and road trailer. This Shetland provides an interesting basis for anyone looking to buy a boat for recreational use on calm waters.

The boat can be viewed during the viewing day. This is the opportunity to carefully assess its general condition, equipment, Yamaha engine and Riba trailer.
