A versatile sailing yacht

The First 25.7 is a compact sailing yacht designed by Jean-Marie Finot, combining the qualities of a cruising yacht with handling characteristics that allow for more dynamic sailing.

Given its size, it remains relatively easy to manoeuvre whilst offering interior space suitable for inshore cruising and multi-day trips.

It is well-suited to an owner looking for a boat that allows them to sail, compete in regattas occasionally and enjoy coastal cruising without having to upgrade to a larger yacht.

Maintenance and recent fittings

The boat has been regularly maintained, with an annual refit, ensuring a consistent maintenance history for the hull.

The mainsail, fitted in 2024, is a recent addition. The companionway cover, also fitted in 2024, is another recent addition to the cockpit and companionway area.

The engine has clocked up approximately 500 hours, which should be considered in light of its age and maintenance history.
