I am proud to present my **Dehler 41 CR**, an exceptional sailboat built in **2000** and surveyed early **2024**. This boat has undergone significant work, including hull hydrojetting and a complete engine overhaul. The standing rigging was replaced in **2024**, and the running rigging, electronics, and electrical systems were checked the same year.

Equipment and Comfort
My **Dehler 41 CR** is equipped for offshore cruising with a full complement of gear, including a **BOMBARD** 6-person liferaft serviced in March **2024**. This boat has never been chartered, ensuring its excellent condition.

The **NAVIONICS LARGE EUROPE** chart coverage includes Europe, the UK, Ireland, and the Netherlands. A portable **GARMIN RAYTHEON R80** GPS is also included.
