This boat has undergone significant work, including hull hydrojetting and a complete engine overhaul. The standing rigging was replaced in <strong>2024</strong>, and the running rigging, electronics, and electrical systems were checked the same year.<h2>Equipment and Comfort</h2>My <strong>Dehler 41 CR</strong> is equipped for offshore cruising with a full complement of gear, including a <strong>BOMBARD</strong> 6-person liferaft serviced in March <strong>2024</strong>. This boat has never been chartered, ensuring its excellent condition.

The <strong>NAVIONICS LARGE EUROPE</strong> chart coverage includes Europe, the UK, Ireland, and the Netherlands. A portable <strong>GARMIN RAYTHEON R80</strong> GPS is also included.
