This Moody 33 Mk I Centre Cockpit, built in 1980, is ideal for coastal cruising or a cross-channel trip. It offers seven berths, in three cabins, including the saloon with an approximate 6'2 ft headroom throughout. This Moody 33 Mk I Centre Cockpit benefits from a Volvo MD2030 engine that was reconditioned in 2018, along with a 108 Litre fuel tank that was replaced in 2023.

This vessel benefits from 2021 navigational equipment, including a Nasa Depth gauge, a Nasa Speed/Log, a Vesper Marine AIS Receiver, a Standard Horizon VHF, and a Raymarine autopilot.

The yacht has just been serviced in September 2025, including antifouling, the keel taken back to bare metal, primed, and antifouled. All seacocks have been serviced, a new cutlass bearing has been installed, and a new bootline has been painted. Furling headsail gear and outboard engine have been serviced, and the main engine has been checked - she is ready to sail away. The owner has enjoyed the vessel for the last 3 years but is selling due to a change of circumstances.

Accommodation :

This Moody 33 MK I Centre Cockpit offers comfortable accommodation for seven across three cabins, including the saloon, with approximately 6'2 headroom throughout. A solid example of Moody's renowned build quality, she combines practicality with classic design.

The forward cabin features a V-berth with infill to convert into a double, complemented by an opening deck hatch for ventilation. Ample storage is provided via shelving and under-berth lockers.

Situated between the fore cabin and saloon, the heads include an electric marine toilet, built-in shower tray, and storage to port.

The spacious saloon offers starboard-side booth seating around a central folding table, with additional storage both beneath and above. This area easily converts to a double berth, ideal for extended cruising.

Located to port, the well-equipped galley includes a two-burner gas cooker with oven and grill, a 12V refrigerator, with small freezer box and a stainless-steel sink with pressurised cold water – everything needed for onboard catering.

Aft to starboard is a quarter berth (requiring reupholstery) and the navigation station, which houses the VHF radio, Garmin GPS, and vessel control switches.

The centre cockpit is secure and comfortable, featuring three generous bench seats, a large starboard locker, binnacle with wheel steering, and engine controls.

The aft cabin offers two single berths over 6 feet in length, a standing/dressing area, and excellent storage options including shelving and under-berth lockers – an ideal private space for guests or family.

<p>Spars & Sails:</p><p>This Moody 33 Mk I Centre Cockpit is a masthead, Bermudan sloop rig with a deck-stepped mast and boom with stainless steel standing rigging. The standing rigging and running rigging were inspected, and the majority were replaced 2021. Furler serviced Sept 2025. </p><p>The vessel is equipped with a furling headsail with an in-mast furling mainsail. All lines are led aft via clutches to coach roof-mounted winches.</p><p>Winches</p> 4 x Lewmar Sheet winches, self-tailing 2 x Lewmar Halyard winches <p>Sails</p> 2 x Mainsail – Condition Unknown, Age Unknown. 1 x Genoa - Condition Unknown, Age Unknown. <p>Mechanical Systems:</p><p>The Moody 33 Centre Cockpit is equipped with a Volvo Penta MD2030 29hp three-cylinder engine, propelling a shaft-mounted three-bladed fixed propeller. This engine is operated via Morse controls. Fuel is supplied by a single 108-litre fuel tank that was replaced in 2023. The engine hours are unknown. This engine benefited from a reconditioning in 2018. The engine was last serviced in 2025.</p><p>This yacht will achieve an approximate cruising speed of 6 knots and has a maximum speed of approximately 8 knots.</p><p>Electrical Systems:</p><p>This Vessel is equipped with two 12-volt batteries (1 x Engine, replaced in 2020 + 1 x Domestic, replaced in 2019). These batteries charge directly from the engine alternator and two 175-Watt and 1 x 50-Watt Solar panels.</p><p> </p>
