In the forecabin V berth with stowage under. Opening hatch to deck. Separate heads to starboard with marine toilet and washbasin. Hanging locker opposite.

In saloon, dinette to starboard (converts to double) with settee berth opposite, upholstery finished in blue velvet. Saloon table with opening leaf.

Chart table to starboard with galley opposite. Wet hanging locker. Two burner gimballed Taylors paraffin cooker with two rings. Stainless steel sink with pressurised pumped water supply. 30-gallon freshwater capacity in stainless steel tank. Cool box with WAECO compressor and evaporator. Radio/CD player new in 2018. Berths fitted with lee cloths. Heated throughout via an Eberspacher diesel heating system.
