<div> <div> <div> <div> <p>This is a rare opportunity to own a classic 1977 sailing yacht by renowned designer Ron
Holland. Known for blending performance, seaworthiness, and classic aesthetics, this yacht is a milestone in yacht
design.</p> <p>Built with a Kevlar and GRP hybrid hull for strength and reduced weight, it offers durability and
enhanced speed. An alloy space frame ensures structural integrity while keeping the weight low.

</p> <p><strong>Refit Histo</strong>r<strong>y &amp; Survey</strong></p> <p>Odette underwent a significant
refit and modernization program completed in 2012/13, after which she served as both a cruiser and a part-time racer for
her former owners. A comprehensive structural survey conducted in March 2014 (available on request for serious
buyers) verified that the refit was executed to a high standard. Additionally, she received a new mast (previously from a
Swan 411), updated standing rigging, and a new Beta engine.</p> <p>O<strong>wners Comments</strong></p> <p>This
remarkable 1977 Ron Holland design is a 42-foot ex-IOR Admirals Cup and Fastnet yacht (completer!). She holds
substantial historical and technical significance, crafted by Ron Holland and Butch Dalrymple-Smith as a sibling to the
renowned 'Imp'. Imp, one of the most successful ocean racing boats in yachting history, made waves in the competitive
sailing world from her debut in January 1977 and continues to win races today. Odette incorporates many of Imp's
design elements, including an alloy space frame and a Kevlar and GRP hull.</p> </div> </div> </div> </div>
<strong>Accommodation :</strong>
<p>The&nbsp;forward cabin<span>&nbsp;features a double berth or sail locker, ample storage, and a roof
hatch. A door leads to the&nbsp;</span>saloon<span>, which includes newly upholstered, long bench seating with
deep shelving for storage behind. On the port side, a straight galley is equipped with a new cooker and fridge, with
plenty of storage in lockers above and below. Moving further aft on the port side, there is access to the engine and a
second cabin with a double berth and storage. To starboard, you'll find an aft-facing chart table that leads to the heads
and a storage locker.</span>

Odette has benefited from new wooden slat panelling headlining with elegant LED light fixtures and
fittings.&nbsp;<span>The flooring is still in progress with synthetic panels being installed.&nbsp;
